



**WEST VIRGINIA JUNIOR COLLEGE
CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT FOR ONLINE COURSES
DISCLOSURES**

On October 29, 2010, the Department of Education published final regulations that require institutions to disclose certain information to students and prospective students regarding consortium agreements.

1. Up to but never to exceed 49% of the program and may be offered through the host institution.
2. Coursework will be delivered in an on line format through the **HOME** institution:
