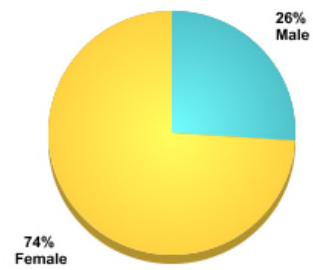

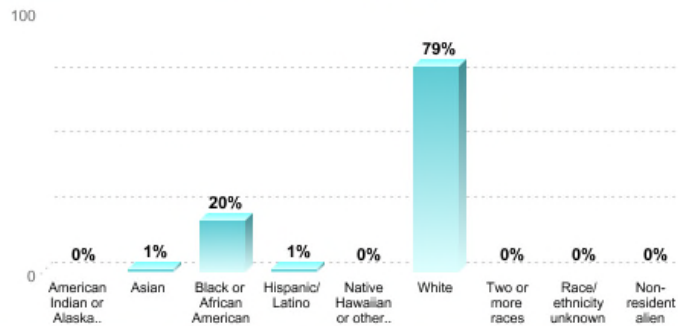
### ATTENDANCE STATUS



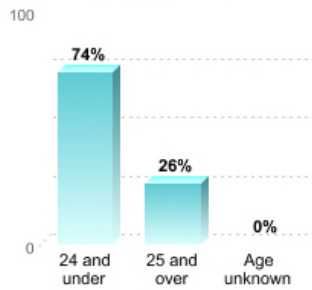
### STUDENT GENDER



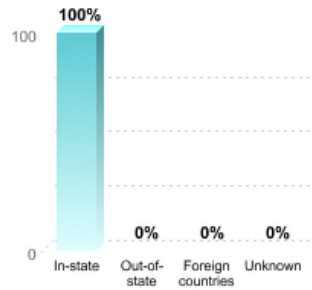
